PIANETA BIANCO

The film challenges the perception between reality and fantasy, raising the question of whether Michele is an elf in a fantasy world or a man destined for self-destruction.

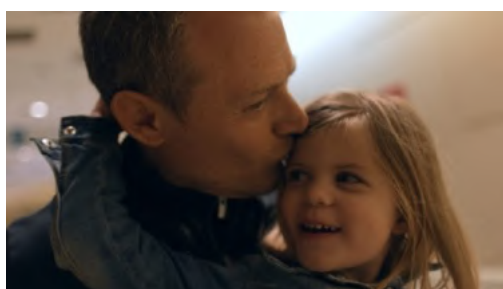


SEGNALI DI VITA
